Question from Lora – Do we have information about year-to-year growth of the LDL. Scott doesn't have that information but will ask at the next meeting.

At the end of the meeting people can report on new collections they've added to the LDL. ULL will post on social media about their new collections.

J Campbell asked about sensitivity flag and if there is a way to blur the image. Sophie Z. replied that they are very interested in this question and will work with the developers about this. LSU was going to bring up this issue, but they are happy that it has come from the LDC membership.

Miriam asked about LAMA and Louisiana historical association for financial support. Sophie added the Society of SW Archivists and LLA.

- Presentation on 9/11 oral history project proposal for LDL Chandler Taylor (Ascension Parish Library) – Chandler sent a revised proposal to the LDC listserv. She is not allowed to travel, so if we would like to do oral histories of post 9/11, we need people to partner with Ascension Parish. Please review the proposal. We are interested in partnering with institutions creating a collection and in creating a collaborative collection.
  - Scott asked for people to let him know if they need a copy of the proposal.
  - Groups she is interested in primarily are military, fire, and police. What happened in Louisiana more so than what happened in NYC. Looking at Louisiana response to this event in the oil and gas industry/refinery.
  - J. Campbell Is this a nationwide project or just Louisiana? Chandler just Louisiana but would hope this will increase national interest. She is not aware of other collections.

 The oral history collection is called "From the Big Easy to the Big Apple: Louisiana Remembers 9/11." I forgot to mention that. And I will be at LLA next month if anyone wants to talk more about it. :)
